January Fishing Forecast

Happy New Year to all! If you are like me, you may have resolved to catch more fish this year (and if you have followed this report you know that my resolution is always the same!) My plan to accomplish this is quite simply to attend fishing club meetings, to gain knowledge from members and guest speakers, and to keep a fishing log (if you already keep a log then refer back to past year's to aid in planning your trips). Logs can be quite basic (a simple notebook or day planner) or elaborate (professional fishing journals, smartphone apps, or other electronic media).

So far, we have seen a fairly mild winter, therefore, our inshore fishing patterns are shaping up similar to last year's bite. Even though our water has not become crystal clear yet, the temperature is dropping. Therefore, January should provide us with a nice sheepshead and black drum bite. Target these fish around docks,

bridges, and deep holes with structure, using fiddler crabs or shrimp. You will also find some nice sea trout patrolling these same waters. As the sun warms up the flats redfish and flounder can be targeted in the shallows with artificial baits (Grandslam Baits, Zman, and Berkley Gulp all have been working well) or live finger mullet.

If the wind will allow a trip to the ledge, January is a great time to target trophy wahoo! High speed trolling ballyhoo with dark skirts (red, purple, blue, and black combinations are popular) or noisy naked lures (also using dark combinations) should entice the big ones. The bottom bite should also heat up as the temperature drops (make sure to check the ever-changing regulations for closures and bag limits). Grouper, sea bass, trigger, and cobia should be waiting for a meal. Drop down live sardines or pinfish or cut sardines or squid to see which baits will ignite the bite.

Tight lines and much happiness to all in 2018!

Happy Holidays Anglers....Only a couple weeks left in the 2017 Yearlong Tournament & the points are close for the Mixed & Men's leaders! Let's see what happens! I will pick up final weigh slips for 2017 on January 2, post to the website & finalize the 2017 results that day. Copies of the final results will be available at the Club Meeting for all members on January 2 and will be considered the publishing of the final results for 2017. According to Yearlong Tournament Rules, anglers have 30 days from that publication - until February 2 - to file a dispute with the Weigh Master if anyone feels there is an error in the results. If you have any issues or questions, please let me know immediately so that we can answer your questions quickly and resolve any errors.

With the addition of the Red Snapper season in 2017 the board felt it appropriate to recognize the Red Snapper catches in a stand-alone species category & they are eligible for the club species award. However, the Red Snapper catches will not be awarded points and will not be included in the Year Long Tournament results.

FYI...I'm sure everyone saw the announcement but just in case...Atlantic Snook Season ended on December 16, 2017 & will reopen February 1, 2018. Let's hope all our little Snook caught the last few months grow up quickly and hang around for the next season:)

2018 Yearlong Tournament Rules are ready and will be posted in full on the website. Overview of the changes for 2018 are...

- The Club will recognize a Lady Angler of the Year & a Male Angler of the Year (Overall has been removed due to duplication). Both Anglers of the year will receive a 1-year Club membership, jacket (or shirt or sponsor gift card) & trophy. The point system does not change for 2018.
- No Angler can win more than one award for the Yearlong Tournament except for a Club Record Award --- Example...Angler of the Year cannot also win a Species Category.....Anglers can win only one Species category... But in any case, would be recognized for a record catch.
- Croaker has been removed from the species list & Red Snapper has been added.
- Backwater Baits has been removed as a Weigh Station. Another Station could be added at a later date --- still to be determined.

I'm really excited to begin our new **Fish of the Month Tournament** in January with Sheepshead. The Angler weighing in the largest Sheepshead during the calendar month of January will be recognized at the February Club Meeting & will be awarded a \$50 gift card of their choice from one of our Sponsors. The Fish of the Month rules will be posted on the Website and the Fish of the Month is pictured in the upper left corner of each month on the Club Calendar.

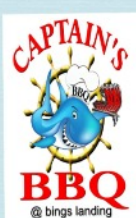
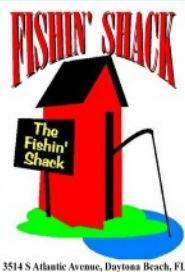
