Recipe of the Month: Smoked Fish Dip By David Genk

Roast fresh plum tomatoes, onions, red pepper and garlic in oven or on BQ grill. Season these with Old Bay and your favorite seasonings. Dice once cooled. Reserve liquid to loosen dip and add flavor at the end if the dip is too thick.

1. Flake smoked fish
2. Drain or squeeze liquid from good amount of sweet relish.
3. Chop up some water chestnuts for crunch factor.
4. Prepared horseradish (from refrigerated case) to add kick
5. Make cream base for dip by blending 1/3 mayo, 1/3 cream cheese, and 1/3 sour cream. Add when combining ingredients as needed at end to reach preferred consistency.

6. Combine ingredients adding salt, pepper, paprika and additional seasonings like hot sauce to taste.
7. Chill beer and call friends.

February Fishing Report by Captain Jim Britton



Inshore, we are starting to get reports of the beginnings of what promises to be a busy snook and tarpon bite. These reports

are coming from southern Flagler county and northern Volusia county and are indicating that both soft plastics and suspending baits will do the trick. Trout can be targeted with your favorite soft plastic on a 1/4 ounce jig head or by using live bait under docks and in deeper drop-offs. Redfish should start to actively roam around more as water temperatures rise. Therefore, targeting redfish around oyster bars with gold spoons and top water baits should work well. During March, anglers will still be able to target keeper size black drum and sheepshead. Look for these fish in deeper holes and around structure. Your bait of choice should be either shrimp or fiddler crabs on a jig head or a fish finder rig.

March should provide a more consistent bite from the bridges and the surf, with whiting, pompano, and blue fish showing up in numbers. Brined shrimp or clams, fresh shrimp, sand fleas, or Fishbites artificial bait on your favorite surf rig should yield a nice fish dinner! Large flounder will be on the move in the ocean as well, and can be caught with live mullet or mud minnows.

Offshore reports from the ledge have anglers finding good numbers of wahoo either trolling bait over live bottom or high-speed trolling. It seems that spring will be early, therefore, large dolphin and blackfin tuna will be caught on darker color lures and ballyhoo as well. Offshore anglers who visit some favorite bottom numbers should be on the lookout for large cobia roaming structure. To hook up these curious creatures, live bait, cut bait or artificial eels will all do the trick.

Conservation and Regulation Update by Captain Tim Jarvis



Recreational gray triggerfish season reopens to harvest in Gulf state and federal waters March 1, 2021. Season will remain open through May 31, 2021 and closing June 1, 2021 through July 31, 2021. This will allow for an annual spawning season closure.

If you plan to fish for gray triggerfish in Gulf state or federal waters (excluding Monroe County) from a private recreational vessel, you must sign up as a [State Reef Fish Angler](#) (annual renewal is required). To learn more, visit [MyFWC.com/Marine](#) and click on "Recreational Regulations" and "State Reef Fish Survey" under "Reef Fish." [Sign up today](#) at [GoOutdoorsFlorida.com](#).

Learn more about [gray triggerfish](#) regulations at [MyFWC.com/Marine](#) by clicking on "Recreational Regulations" and "Triggerfish," which is under the "Reef Fish" tab.

Don't forget! Flounder changes go into effect March 1, 2021.

- Extending ALL FWC flounder regulations into federal waters.
- Increasing the minimum size limit from 12 inches to 14 inches total length (recreational and commercial).
- Reducing the recreational daily bag limit from 10 to 5 fish per person.
- Establishing an Oct. 15 – Nov. 30 recreational closed season.

- For commercial harvesters using allowable gear: Establishing a commercial trip and vessel limit of 150 fish from Dec. 1 – Oct. 14, and 50 fish from Oct. 15 – Nov. 30.
- Modifying the incidental bycatch limit for commercial harvesters using non-allowable gear from 50 pounds to 50 fish/trip.
- Creating a federal waters trawl bycatch limit of 150 flounder/trip from Dec. 1 – Oct. 14, and 50 fish/trip from Oct. 15 – Nov. 30.




