Recipe of the Month: Honey Orange-Glazed Florida Grouper



Ingredients:

1 TBS Honey
1 TBS Orange Marmalade
1 TBS Orange juice
3/4 tsp Dijon Mustard
1/2 tsp Light Soy Sauce
1/8 tsp Ground white pepper
3/4 pound Florida Grouper

Preparation:

Preheat broiler.
Combine all ingredients except grouper, mixing well.
Place fillets on an oiled broiler pan and brush fillets with honey glaze to cover.
Broil 5 to 6 inches from heat for 4 to 5 minutes until browned.
Turn fillets, brush with honey glaze and broil an additional 5 minutes or until fish flakes easily.

Yields 4 servings

September Fishing Report by Captain Tim Jarvis



September can be a tricky month because you don't know if it will be hot or cold. It is also the start to the fall tides and mullet run.

Inshore tarpon fishing can still be good in September in the canals, creeks, and ICW. Pitch a freelined shrimp, mullet, pinfish or shrimp under a cork. Top water jerk baits with no weight and mirrodine lures also work well. First light top water action on the flats and ICW has been good. Fish the banks for Redfish, Trout, Jack and Snook.

There should be some good flood tides this month for tailing redfish in the grass. I like to throw weedless baits. Also try the grass edges with a popping cork and shrimp at high tide.

Offshore bottom fishing can be good this month in about 80-100 feet of water. If you are looking for Snapper and Grouper, use 50-60 pound leader with any live or cut bait with a 4/0-5/0 circle hook.

Try a freelined bait while you are fishing the bottom for the occasional Cobia, Mutton Snapper, Kingfish or Amberjack anchor up current from the structure you're fishing. Slow troll naked Ballyhoo with 80-pound mono in 80-200 feet of water for kingfish and maybe some sailfish if we get a cold front.

Surf and Pier, September can be a good month fishing from the pier and surf due to the Mullet run. Use a Mullet on a knocker rig for Bluefish, Redfish and Flounder.

Try throwing spoons, Gotcha Plugs and Yo Zuri plugs for Spanish Mackerel and Bluefish. Pompano fishing can also be good this month use Pompano jigs or a Pompano rig with sandfleas or shrimp.

Minutes from August Meeting by Carol Carter, Secretary

Meeting called to order by President, Chris Christian

Pledge of Allegiance – Presented by Ron Gorney

Passing of July 06, 2021 Minutes, Motion made by Tim Miller, seconded by Carol Carter. Minutes accepted.

Welcome New Members/Visitors/First Responders – Guests / New Members 3

Welcome Annual Sponsors: CCI – Dana Syens of CCI handles all kinds of insurance. Chris said he got insurance advice from Dana, and she steered him in the right direction for the coverage he needed.

Special Affirmation of Budget Change – Chris Christian addressed the membership with some changes to the budget that needed their approval.

1. Bookkeeper Expense - \$750.00 for the rest of the year at \$150 a month. The purpose of this is to keep our financial records in Quick Books and relieve the requirement of knowing Quick Books from the Treasurer position.
2. Increase Charitable Donation to Disabled American Veterans (DAV-This was set as a minimum of \$10,000.00 and the Board voted to donate \$12,000.00.
3. CCA Youth Scholarship Donation – This was deleted from the budget this year as we wanted to see how the Covid Year affected our Club. Our Club is flourishing, and the Board voted to put this donation back in the budget. It is a \$5,000.00 donation that is only awarded to a Flagler County participant.

We need a vote from the members to approve these changes, need a motion to be made. **Motion was made by Gary Fisher to accept these budget changes and was seconded by Mike Crotts. All in favor, motion carried.**

Reports:

Finance Report: Tim Miller said the club is doing well, we are showing a net profit of \$19,400.00. We have a holiday party coming up shortly and the budget is good for the next expenses we have. \$6,700.00 has been given out in the tournaments so far for this year. All is going well. A review of all of our books has been done and everything is good. Books were officially audited as requested.

Weigh Master Report: Fish of the Month – Chuck Radloff reported that Mark Heffley is in the lead for the men's division in the Year Long Tournament, with Tim Miller and Aby Moghanaki at his heels. Lauren Oakwood is leading in the Ladies Division. Fish of the month for July was Flounder, Aby Moghanaki won with a 4 lb. 15 oz flounder he chose a \$50.00 gift card. FOM for August is Snapper (not Red). CPR has over 200 entries, Deborah McGriff is selling bump boards that are needed for the CPR entries. Winners of the Red Snapper Tournament held July 9-11th are 1st place- Jude Lukaszewski, 20 lb., 8 oz, 2nd pl. Amy Beth Krisanda, 16 lb., 6 oz, 3rd pl.-Michael Brandon, 14 lb., 10 oz, 4th pl. Bruce Bachman Jr., 14 lb., 10 oz, 5th pl. Lauren Oakwood, 14 lb., 6 oz.

Tournament Director Report: Tim Miller said on July 16-17, the Overnight Tournament was held and chaired by Gary Fisher and helper, Ernie Morris from the DAV, went well, there was a good turnout, nice fish brought in and had good food. On Sept. 11th is the Pier Tournament, chaired by Ron Gorney.

Upcoming Tournaments: Mike Crotts will be chairing the Club Trash & Trash Fish Tournament. on August 21st. Flyer with details will be in the August Chum Line. Tim said on Sept. 25th will be the Club Member's Classic. This will be a paid tournament, fee for members will be \$25.00, with the participation of 40 anglers, the prize money will be \$3,000.00 and you can win more than one place. A flyer is being put together and it will be in your Chum Line. Weigh in will be at Herschel King Park. David Genk on Aug. 7th is chairing the New Members and Existing Members Clinic. Starts at 7:30 AM with breakfast, lunch at 11:30 AM, experienced speakers, wraps up between 1 – 1:30 PM. **Litter Gitter Trip** this morning had a total of 4 people and they picked up 376 lbs. of trash – Congrats!

Kid's Clinic Review – Betty Christian said the clinic had 70 kids and a total of 159 people. The kids went through the stations ten at a time, got a free rod and fished on the dock. Fish they caught were flounder, redfish, mangrove snapper, ages were 5-13 yrs. old. Frank Meekins distributed the hot dogs, chips and candies and drinks.

Break

Guest Speaker: Capt. Adam Morley from Genung's Fish Camp – **Adam** said the Litter Gitter trip is on the first Tuesday of every month and he thanked the crew from this morning's trip. This is the Matanzas River Keeper's boat; they are approaching 50 tons of trash. There is a table for the Matanzas River Keeper set up in the back of the room, see Lauren Price for information on what they do to help the environment. Adam said they are seeing more and more trash as time goes by. There is a misconception of how litter gets into the intercoastal. Now there is more trash in the environment, more light weight and single use trash. Motto is "Pack it in, Pack it out." Adam works with the Friends of AIA, providing trash cans at the parks is part of the problem, the cans attract critters and birds, and the heavy winds can move the trash around and the trash trucks can disturb the trash when they empty the cans. Some cans have been removed like at River-to-Sea. There is 400 million tons of plastic and only 9% of it gets recycled, 10-15% is getting lost to the environment. Avoid single use plastics, use your own grocery bags and try to reduce the plastic that you use. Ask producers and manufacturers to not use single use packages. Water Pollution – Palm Coast was built for 40,000 people and it now has 90 thousand people. We are getting a lot of lawn fertilizer in the waterways that fuels algae bloom, which is detrimental to our fishing. Get involved with organizations that will help educate you as to when to fertilize and how to treat your lawn. Do little actions now to impact the future. The best example as a leader, is to lead by example – Adam said!


