Recipe of the Month: Charbroiled Oysters From Dragos



Ingredients

- 32 Oysters on the half shell
- l cup butter
- 2 TBS finely chopped garlic
- 1/2 teas fresh ground black pepper
- 1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 cup grated Pecorino Romano cheese
- 1/2 cup finely chopped parsley

Directions

- Heat grill to med-high
- Melt butter with garlic and pepper in a large skillet
- Mix Parmesan and Pecorino Romano cheese in a small bowl
- Spoon some of the melted butter mixture onto each oyster
- Add a pinch of the combined cheese to each oyster, add a pinch of parsley
- Place oysters on the grill
- Grill oysters until they are hot, bubbly and puffed, about 8 minutes

January Fishing Report by Captain Tim Jarvis



Happy New Year! Hope everyone had a great 2021. For a good New Year's resolution try new spots and new techniques.

This month will be the sheepshead tournament on January 22nd. My favorite baits and rigs for sheepsheads is fiddler crabs and shrimp on a crusher jig or a 1/0-2/0 circle hook with a split shot weight just above the hook, I like to target the bridges, dock pilings and rock piles but the inlet can produce some of the bigger sheepshead. For redfish, trout and flounder fish the creeks and flats with your favorite soft plastics or shrimp and mud minnow on a 1/8 or 1/4 jigheads. Remember to be very quiet when fishing these shallow waters because the fish can spook very easyily.



Each month the Club sponsors a Litter Gitter Trip to pick up trash in the Intracoastal Waterway area. The Litter Gitter is run by the Matanzas River Keeper and is a volunteer group. Captain Adam Morley is your host and will have everything you need to fill the boat. This is not a member only event, so grab a friend or neighbor to join you in helping out the environment. This is a 2 hour tour and you depart from Bings Landing on the First Tuesday of every month starting at 10am and 1pm. Click here to sign-up.

Next trip is Tuesday, February 2nd from 10am-12pm and 12pm-2pm from Bings Landing.



The surf and pier fishing has been good with whiting, black drum, pompano and flounder with the occasional trout and redfish. Use shrimp, clams and sandfleas if you can catch them on a pompano rig or jigheads.

Offshore

The bottom bite can be good when the temperature drops for grouper, seabass, snapper and trigger fish, use pinfish, sardines or squid. If the weather is calm enough and you can make it to the ledge, it could be a good month for big wahoo or sailfish. High speed troll with rigged ballyhoo or your favorite lures with dark colors.
