Recipe of the Month: Garlic Shrimp Linguini By Chris Christian

- Ilb fresh/local shrimp. Deveined and shelled. Put in small Ziploc bag with olive oil and garlic salt ahead of time. Refrigerate until cooking time.
- 2. 8oz of Linguini
- 8 cloves of garlic cut into tiny pieces (not chopped or minced)
- 4. 1/2 medium onion—cut into small pieces
- 5. 1/2 stick of real butter
- 6. 1 Tbsp. Oregano
- 7. l cup Pasta Water
- 8. 2 Tbsp. olive oil
- 9. Salt and pepper

Directions

- Cook Linguini and pour off 1 cup of the 9. water for later.
- Keep your pasta warm in a colander in a covered pan of warm water.
- Using the pan you cooked the pasta in, pour some olive oil in the bottom on med

- to med low heat.
- 4. Put the onions, butter and oregano in and cook the onions until transparent.
- Add the garlic and cook a little, add salt and pepper and pour the cup of pasta water into the pan.
- When this has cooked a few minutes, add your shrimp.
- 7. When the shrimp is a tight "C", then they are done. DO NOT LET THIS SIT AS IT WILL OVERCOOK THE SHRIMP.
- 8. Add the pasta into this pan and mix together with everything, Remove from the burner.
- 9. Put on a plate and add parmesan cheese on top.

December Fishing Report by Captain Tim Jarvis



Inshore Anglers

The water is super clean right now which makes for my favorite kind of fishing when the wind allows it, sight fishing for redfish and trout can

be really fun right now. They are starting to school up and the key is to move slowly with the trolling motor or push pole make sure you have a good pair of polarized sunglasses. Use a live shrimp or your favorite soft plastic for bait and down size your weight and leader cause these fish can be very spooky. If this isn't your kind of fishing try the creek holes and river banks with freelined shrimp or jighead with a shrimp and fiddler crabs for trout, redfish, sheepshead and maybe occasional pompano.

There should be a lot of sheepsheads and black drum around docks, bridges and rocky banks.

Surf & Pier

Whiting, sheepshead and pompano will be your best bet right now. Use fiddler crabs,

sand fleas and clams on a pompano rig or tip a pompano jig with any of these baits. They might be out far with the dunes being high from the high water pushing all the sand up on the beach so make sure you have at least a 10 foot surf rod to get your bait out there. You might see good numbers of redfish, trout, flounder and weakfish too.

Offshore Anglers


Try nearshore wrecks for amberjacks, triggerfish, snapper and grouper fishing the bottom with your favorite cut bait on a knocker rig. If the weather allows it try the ledge for wahoo and maybe sailfish trolling ballyhoo or your favorite trolling lures around 9-15 knots.

Tournament Director Report: Tim Miller said the 2nd Surf Tournament of this year was held on Oct. 23rd, with the weigh in at Betty Steflik Preserve. It was a good tournament, not many fish were caught and they had to draw for two places. Always bring your catch to the weigh in, the fish you don't bring to weigh in could give you a nice prize. Come to the weigh-ins, you can win prizes in the raffles, money in the 50/50 and the food is free!

Upcoming Tournaments - Red, White and Blue Tournament - Ron Gorney said this tournament will be held on Nov. 13, 2021, fish from anywhere. Weigh in will be held at Bings Landing from 2-3 PM, there will be prizes for redfish, whiting (11" minimum) and bluefish & heaviest combo, show up prize, good food and also a prize for red, white & blue costume. Sign-up sheet is on the back table and also a volunteer sheet. You can buy your raffle tickets tonight and put your name on the back if you won't make it to the weigh in.

Guest Speaker: Cpt. Cullen Traverso has charters out of St. Augustine, he will talk to us tonight about fishing for redfish. He has been a fishing guide in St. Augustine for 3-4 years now. He said you need to pay attention to the tides and the weather, check your vessel, and make notes if you pre-fish ahead on your phone. Use Fishfinder to help you. Get your rigging done the night before you fish and have a game plan. See what your surroundings are doing, the birds, the bait and the fish. Go after your hardest species first and then go down the line if you are fishing in a tournament. Every advantage is an advantage to give you a successful outcome. Don't give up, fish hard and don't get discouraged, he sight Communicate with your partner, invest in good equipment like polarized glasses. Push yourself to get better and take notes to keep a log of your day. Fish try to stay away from predators, when sight fishing, keep scanning the waters for any changes. Solo sight fishing is harder to do. If fishing in oyster and structures, throw a weedless using a 10 lb. braided line, shoot the baitfish past the fish and bring it to them. At first light, fish a topwater plug, the fish are in ambush mode. Reds will hit on a soft plastic if they think they have injured a bait. Pay attention to the tides. Reds right now are gorging on small crabs and shrimp in shallow wa-


