

# Recipe of the Month: Honey Orange-Glazed Florida Grouper



Ingredients:
1TSP honey
1 TBS Orange Marmalade
1 TSP Orange Juice
3/4 tsp Dijon mustard
1/2 tsp light soy sauce
1/8 tsp ground white pepper
3/4 pound Florida grouper fillets

Yield 4 servings

Preparation

Preheat Broiler.

Combine all ingredients except grouper, mixing well.

Place fillets on an oiled broiler pan and brush fillets with honey glaze to cover.

Broil 5 to 6 inches from heat for 4 to 5 minutes until browned.

Turn fillets, brush with honey glaze and broil an additional 5 minutes or until fish flakes easily.

You can use Croaker, Flounder, Grunt, Pompano, Sheepshead, Spot, Tilefish or Whiting as a substitute.

# **February Fishing Report** by Captain Tim Jarvis



Inshore fishing should stay pretty good for the month of February specially for sight fishing for redfish on the shallow flats and creeks. I like the last three hours of

outgoing and the first three of incoming tides.

Try smaller baits like shrimp and jigs with 15-20lb fluorocarbon leader and be very quiet when you target these fish! For those fishing the black and red club tournament Feb 19<sup>th</sup>, I would try to get the winning redfish on the shallow water flats with live mullet or cut bait like ladyfish or blue crabs. For the black drum I would fish docks, bridges, deep creek holes and the inlet with live shrimp, fiddler crabs or clams. Snook season opens Feb 1<sup>st</sup> remember its 1 per harvester per day not less than 28" or more than 32" length.



There has been some good black drum and occasional redfish for the tournament anglers fishing from the surf or piers. Use shrimp, fiddler crabs and clams for black drum and live or dead mullet for redfish. Pompano, sheepshead, trout and bluefish can also be targeted with pompano rigs, spoons and gotcha plugs.

#### Offshore

The wahoo and sailfish bite should be good at the ledge if the weather allows it, high speed troll your favorite lures with darker color patterns for these fish or a rigged ballyhoo. For bottom anglers the trigger fish bite could be good with occasional cobia on the reefs and wrecks.
