## August Fishing Report by Captain Tim Jarvis

Offshore: Slow troll with live bait on wrecks, reefs and ledges for kingfish while always looking for birds and bait on top of the water. If you prefer to Bottom fish, try finding some good current and put out a few chum bags for mangrove snapper, mutton snapper and an occasional kingfish. Try drifting over wrecks and ledges, using a double rig or a knocker rig. Also you can use ledge anglers troll rigged ballyhoo for dolphin, wahoo and sailfish—look for birds or debris on top of the water.

For Nearshore and our surf and pier anglers you will continue to catch whiting, bluefish, flounder and pompano using sandfleas, fiddler crabs and live shrimp. Flounder has been biting well at the inlets and local beaches. Try jighead with any live bait or ½ jigheads with paddle tails. August is a great month for trolling behind the shrimp boats for sharks and tarpon. Troll big, live baits like mullet or pogies.

Inshore. Snook, Redfish and Trout on top water plugs or jerk baits around the oyster bars and grass edges on the flats has been great this summer so keep doing that first thing in the morning and the last 2 hours in the evening.

When it heats up switch to live bait, either popping cork and shrimp and also

try live mullet or cut bait. Fish the banks around the inlet for a mixed bag everything from snapper to tarpon. I like to free line a shrimp, croaker, or mullet for any of these species on a quarter ounce to half ounce jig head with a shrimp, croaker or your favorite live bait or artificial bait. Flounder bite should still be one of the better bites this month. Fish the grass banks, drop-offs, rocks and creek holes with a 1/4 oz jighead with any live bait or your favorite paddle tail and slowly drag it on the bottom.

**Weigh Master Report: Fish of the Month:** Chuck Radloff said the Yearlong Tournament sheets are at the back table. In the lead for Lady Angler is Carol Tilley, for Male Angler it is Tim Miller. The winner for the Fish of the Month for June was Chris Davy with a 24 lb. Dolphin fish, he received a \$50.00 gift card. July FOM is Flounder and August is Snapper (not Red). ### **Guest Speaker: Steven McKaig w/Sea Deck, speaking on Snook Fishing**

Vice President, Carlos Garcia introduced Steven to the members. Steven said he used no live bait, only artificials, he said he uses a 4000 Shimano reel with 15 lb. Power Pro and 40 lb. mono. He said to cast against the current. You can find snook under dock lights, he uses paddle tail with a 1 oz jig and a 4 or 5 aught, fishes Slayers. Right now, snook and redfish are hanging together. Target the reds by putting the bait in front of them. When fishing the bridges, most have lights that put out a shadow line, stay in the dark area and let the bait go through the lighted area. For morning fishing, use a top water bait for snook, walk the dog method works – click it and walk it. Carlos said he uses topwater bait in the early morning at predawn, early light. Throw a weedless hook and put on a Slayer. Some nights they will be there but not eating anything you throw at them. Steven got 4<sup>th</sup> place in a Pro tournament in Louisiana. Tie your leader, use a weedless jighead, and slide the artificial bait on it. Snook can break you off. He uses 15 lb. braid with a 6-foot leader and a FG knot that makes a tighter knot. Question from the audience if he uses a scent for the Voodoo Shrimp? He said he has used ProCure before. Question – Does the bite shut down at night? He said no, he doesn't see where it ever turns off. Color preferences for artificial – Trout like green and snook like Goldigger & dark colors. When fishing with a full moon out, there is more light, and it dims down the shadow line.


