OCTOBER FISHING REPORT BY CAPTAIN TIM JARVIS

Inshore

October can be a good month for fishing with the weather cooling down and the mullet run in full effect. I like to start the morning with topwater lures or jerk baits on the flats, creeks and the banks of the ICW. Look for feeding fish and birds and you should find redfish, snook, jacks and ladyfish feeding on the mullet. If bait is your thing cast net mullet and use them under a popping cork or on a ¼ oz jighead. Flounder bite should pick up at the inlet and the creeks holes. Use a ¼ oz jig head with a live mullet or try a scented paddle tail.

Surf & inlet

With the mullet run the surf and inlets will be awesome fishing for the next couple months. Look for big redfish, snook, tarpon and sharks crashing on the mullet in the surf and around the jetties at the inlet. Try buck tail jigs and big swim baits for the live bait anglers try live or cut mullet on a knocker rig. Pompano, flounder and sheepshead bite should pick up this month with the cooler weather. Use pompano rig with your favorite live bait or the fish bites work really well too.

Offshore: Hit reefs from the 10-20 mile range for Grouper, Snapper, Seabass and possibly Cobia and Amber Jack. Troll from spot to spot for Sailfish with a Ballyhoo or your favorite trolling lures, do the same if you fish the ledge for dolphin and wahoo.

Upcoming Tournaments: Saturday, Sept. 10 th will be the Pier Trnmt., there will be 10 winning places. Held at the Flagler Fishing Pier, there will be raffle prizes, 50/50 drawing and a show up ticket drawing. Trnmt starts at 6 AM, weigh in from 11-11:30 AM. Only one rod per angler, high tide will be 8 or 9 in the morning. There will be no food, the Pier Pass will be paid for by the club. Member Classic Trnmt. will be held on Sept. 24th, fishing starts at 6:30 AM, weigh in will be from 2-3 PM, you must be in line by 3 PM with your fish. This is a paid member trnmt, cost will be \$25.00 per member, cost to a guest fishing with a member will be \$75.00. SEPTEMBER MEETING MINUTES CONTINUED

We need a tournament director for this event, please let Tim Miller know if you are interested in chairing this. Tim said the CPR is doing well, so far – 20 members have entered fish, get a bump board from the Quartermaster, Deb McGriff and get started entering. The first fish gets you a ticket and after the next 5, you get another ticket.

Membership Report – Quinn Bui was absent tonight, Deb Marinco reported on the membership total and Christmas Party in the Finance Report section.

Break

Guest Speakers: Our expert fishermen, Tim Miller and Ron Gorney were our speakers tonight to talk about Pier Fishing. Tim asked, "In this tournament, do you want the biggest fish or the most species"? If you are fishing for the biggest flounder, drum or redfish, get live mullet or live shrimp, use big tackle, the whiting has to be 11". Be careful of the surfers at the pier, they tend to hang out closer to the pier than the anglers would like them to be. If using shrimp for the Black Drum, pinch the tail to put a scent in the water. If using a spinning rod for whiting, use a small hook with a small bait. Ron Gorney said he uses a Gotcha Plug, a size medium to heavy 7 ft rod and fill your reel up with line, 40–50 pound braid, 10 pound monofilament leader with a 60–80 pound test, but don't use too heavy a sinker, it might scare the fish away. Tim also said to prep the night before the trnmt – use sharp hooks, check your line, mono and leader for frays or knicks, take the time to check your gear. Tim uses 40 lb mono and said to control the fish, they want to wrap you around the pier and it can cut your line off. Tim also uses a sinker, slider, swivel leader with 1 oz to 8 oz sinkers. If we get south winds, the water will be muddy or like chocolate milk (yoohoo), use dead shrimp.


